SITE GUIDELINES

Welcome to Culford School! To maintain a safe, enjoyable, and respectful atmosphere for all, we kindly ask that visitors follow these guidelines:



Parking:

Upon arrival there are multiple free car parking zones around the venue (Please see site map attached).

NO PARKING IS PERMITTED ON ANY GRASSED AREAS.

Movement and Restrictions:

Public footpaths and movement around the site should is restricted, with no visitors allowed near the boarding houses. Visitors must stay on the pitches, at the sports centre, or on public footpaths.

Canteen and Toilets:

The canteen and toilets are in the main sports centre building. There is also help desk at the sports centre.

Pitches:

Please see map below of our 5 aside, 7 aside, 9 aside and 11 aside match pitches.

Spectators:

Spectators can watch from behind the respect lines. As a Community Football Club we ask that all visiting supporters encourage and support players in the spirit of the game and refrain from foul and abusive language and behaviour of any kind.

MATCH PITCHES



In order to prevent injuries to players and all players, managers, coaches, officials, and spectators are requested to follow the rules below specifically for this area.

- Please leave school grounds to smoke/vape as the school is a non-smoking/vaping site.
- No glass bottles, cans, food or chewing gum.
- Take all personal belongings and litter off the pitch with you.
- Make sure all rubbish is removed from the pitch when finishing your match.
- Spectators are to remain behind the respect lines at all times.
- No spectators should enter the pitch or behind the goal areas.
- Only team officials are allowed in the technical areas.
